Appendix 5 – Inclusion Dispensation

1. Purpose

- (A) To increase the opportunity for players with an intellectual impairment to participate in Open age Community Football by allowing them to be selected on a Team Sheet as an additional Player to the maximum number of players allowed as per Rule 14.4.
- (B) If a Player with an Inclusion Dispensation is selected to a Men's Reserve Grade or Women's Reserve Grade Team, the Team may exceed the Maximum Number of Players allowed on a Team Sheet, as per <u>Table 14</u>, by one (1) player.

2. Application Process

- (A) A Player may apply for an Inclusion Dispensation on the basis of an intellectual impairment by submitting an application in accordance with Appendix Five Clause 2(B).
- (B) An application for dispensation under Appendix Five Clause 2(A) must be:
 - (i) in the form of the AFL South Coast Inclusion Dispensation Form;
 - (ii) submitted via the Player's Club to the Controlling Body;
 - (iii) supported by written consent from the Player's parent or guardian where the player is an Underage Player; and
 - (iv) supported by confirmation the Player has an intellectual impairment as determined by <u>Sport Inclusion Australia</u> based on the Sport Inclusion Australia Athlete Registration and Primary Eligibility Application Guidance Notes;
 - (v) In relation to an application for dispensation, a Medical Specialist may, in their supporting Certificate, recommend that dispensation be approved for two seasons.
- (C) Following its assessment of an application for dispensation, the Controlling Body may:
 - (i) approve the application;
 - (ii) refuse the application; or
 - (iii) request additional information from the Player or Club and, following its assessment of such additional information, either approve or refuse the application.

3. Relevant Factors in Assessing Application

In assessing an application for dispensation, a Controlling Body will have regard to the following factors:

- (A) how the Player's Intellectual Impairment impacts their ability to effectively participate in Australian Football.
- (B) the supporting Certificate provided under Appendix Five Clause 2(B) and any recommendation under Appendix Five Clause 2(C);
- (C) how it is proposed that the grant of Inclusion dispensation will support the Player to overcome any barriers to their effective participation in Australian Football arising from their Intellectual impairment;
- (D) the safety and welfare of the Player and those Players they will be participating with and against; and
- (E) any other relevant factors as determined by the Controlling Body.

4. Effect of Approved Application

- (A) A Player who has received dispensation approval (Permitted Player) will be permitted to be named as a:
 - (i) twenty-third (23) Player on their Club's Men's Reserve Grade Team Sheet; or
 - (ii) twenty-first (21) Player on their Club's Women's Reserve Grade team sheet.
- (B) If, following receipt of dispensation approval, a Permitted Player plays in a higher ranked competition grade, the dispensation approval will be automatically withdrawn.
- (C) A dispensation approval applies for the season in which the dispensation approval is granted unless the Controlling Body endorses a recommendation under Appendix Five Clause 2(C) in which case the dispensation approval will apply for the season in which the dispensation approval is granted and the following season (i.e. two seasons).
- (D) A Controlling Body may, acting reasonably, revoke a dispensation approval at any time provided that the reasons for such revocation are provided to the Permitted Player.

5. Matchday Application of Inclusion Dispensation

- IV. A Player selected to a Team for a Match who has been granted Inclusion dispensation must be identified on all copies of the Team Sheet with "(ID)" handwritten next to their name.
- V. Copies of the Team Sheet must be distributed as follows:
 - (i) one (1) provided to the Ground Manager;
 - (ii) one (1) provided to the Field Umpires; and
 - (iii) one (1) provided to the opposition Club's Team Manager.
- VI. Each of the parties listed in Appendix Five 5(C) must be advised of the circumstances in which the Player will be participating in the Match and discuss any measures that need to be put in place to manage the safety and welfare of the Player while participating in the Match as approved by the CMC.

- VII. The Club fielding a Player with an Inclusion Dispensation should contact their opposition Club as soon as practicable to advise them of the Player's participation in the Match to allow reasonable attempts to be made by the opposition Club to inform their Players and Officials prior to the day of the Match.
- VIII. The League will communicate a list of all Clubs which have Player(s) with an approved Inclusion dispensation as soon as practicable. This list will be housed in the League's 'Club Executive' Microsoft Teams Folder and updated accordingly.
- IX. Should a Club question the status of an approved Player, they can submit a request for Proof of Player Eligibility as outlined in Rule 11.2.6.

6. Appeal

A decision by a Controlling Body under Appendix Five Clause 2(D) may be appealed in accordance with <u>Section 26</u> of the Policy Handbook
