As Senior Coach you will be required to work directly with the AFL South Coast Football Operations Coordinator, have exceptional leadership skills and an excellent knowledge of AFL South Coast players and competitions.

- Foundation Coaching Qualification
- Senior coaching experience
- Demonstrated personal initiative and ability to work effectively unsupervised.
- Demonstrated attention to detail
- Well developed verbal and written communication, interpersonal, presentation, and negotiation skills

Desirable

- Intimate knowledge of AFL South Coast
- Level 2 (or higher) Coaching Qualification

Availability

The following is a list of the expectations of the Senior Coach.

- Saturday 18th May attend representative match in Newcastle
- Set, coordinate and attend squad training sessions on selected nights prior to the match
- Various weekends and evenings as required to attend selection meetings as well as AFL South Coast matches to assist with selections
- Provide regular feedback to players and AFL South Coast Club Coaches on expectations and performance
